This statement is required by AKC that at every licensed or member club trial, included in the entry fee is a recording fee of \$3.50 required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each additional entry of the same dog. <u>Transfer: After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to the next class level.</u> This transfer may be requested if, according to the owner's records the dog has completed the requirements for the title. Transfers may be approved, provided the next level class and the judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. Please contact the trial secretary for trial transfer forms. Transfers will be allowed only up to 1/2hr before start of next trial.

On rally transfer forms if a class requires a jump height you as the owner/handler are solely responsible for that information on the transfer form.
