Entries will not be accepted without proper entry fee. Acknowledgement of entries will be made via the email you provided. Make sure your **email address is CLEARLY PRINTED** on the entry form. **SHOULD ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary. Express delivery services must include signature waiver permitting them to be left WITHOUT recipient's signature.

JUMP HEIGHTS

If your Rally class requires a jump height (because the class will be ordered by jump height) you **MUST** supply a jump height on your entry form or the trial secretary will not accept your entry. The Trial Secretary will **not** contact you for this information.

- Rally transfers from Rally Novice to Rally Intermediate require a jump height on the transfer form. You are expected to understand the Rally Rules and understand which Rally class "A" or "B" at any level to enter. The rules differ between the Rally Novice class, Intermediate and Advanced/Excellent and Master classes. Be advised that your leg will not count if you earn it in the wrong class! Consult the AKC rules for Rally at www.akc.org

- This statement is required by AKC that at every licensed or member club Trial, included in the entry fee is a recording fee of \$3.50 required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each additional entry of the same dog. (This is not a separate fee it is already added into the first entry fee)

*These fees are collected by the club giving the trial and paid to the American Kennel Club. (New AKC rule effective 9/1/2011)

- The following statement required by AKC64: "Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

MOVE-UPS: After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed. This move-up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class and the judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. Please contact the trial secretary for trial move-up forms and be prepared to supply jump heights for move-up classes Move-ups will be allowed only before start of trial. Secretary is not responsible for making sure you have entered the correct A or B class.

NO REFUNDS after closing date except for Bitches in season. Please see policy below.

REFUND POLICY for Bitches in Season

The entry fee less a \$10.00 processing fee will be refunded upon written request to the Trial Secretary for a bitch coming into season after the closing date of entries for this rally trial. If written notification is received by the Trial Secretary PRIOR TO ENTRY CLOSE DATE. Due to workload, refunds cannot be made on day of trial; they will be mailed after the trial is over.

- **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SIGNED!** Mail entry with proper fees as per instructions on entry forms. Telephone, or e-mail entries will not be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms (including back side) will not be accepted.
- Judging schedule & Course Maps will be emailed prior to trial. (Please make sure you **PRINT** your email address)
- Consult the judging schedule for your approximate time of entering the ring. Dogs should be present at least 30 minutes prior to being judged.
- In the event of an emergency, MADTA reserves the right to Add/Substitute judges.
- Notice that MADTA may cancel any/all of this event due to extreme weather conditions or any other unforeseeable disaster/Virus.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Club officials, participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to that area and site where the event is held.
2. Everyone must practice social distancing Please avoid congregating in one area.
3. Plenty of Hand Sanitizer will be available. PLEASE still consider washing hands frequently or wearing disposable gloves.
4. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
5. Avoid touching dogs that are not yours.
6. **MASKS** must be worn while in the building with the exception of being in the ring.
7. **Temperatures will be taken at the door each morning**
8. **WAIVERS must be signed in order to receive your Armbands. BRING SIGNED WAIVER TO TRIAL There will be extra waivers available at the door.**
9. Exhibitors should be present prior to start of their class and must report to the ring steward table upon arrival. Dogs must be at ringside when scheduled to be judged or risk disqualification. If you have a conflict with multiple ring entry times, notify the judges by telling the table stewards and wait for the judge's response. JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. Owners or Agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
10. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
11. Exhibitors must have their dogs use the identified Exercise Area outside the trial facility and please clean up after their dog. Should your dog have an accident inside the facility please ask for cleaning supplies.
12. **No RV** overnight parking available at trial site. Hotels and Motels in the area are in the premium. It is recommended that you make reservations early.
13. Exhibitors are reminded to bring their own chairs and Lunch as **no food is sold at this trial**. Fast food restaurants are abt. 10 mins from trial site on Hwy 40 near I-75.
14. A half hour lunch break may be taken by the Judges at their discretion.
15. NO Food in the Ring at any time. No PRACTICING in the Ring of any kind between Friday and Sunday
16. ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. **NO FLEXI LEADS permitted.**

17. Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules are allowed on the show site. **Dogs NOT entered in the trial are not permitted on the show site.**
18. **DUE TO LIMITED SPACE OF APROX 38 6 X 6 Spaces, are on a first come first served bases the morning of each Trial. NO OVERNIGHT CRATING ALLOWED. NO EXPENS are allowed**
19. The safety of the handlers and dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitor acknowledges that they are familiar with the rules and regulations for this sport.
20. Shoes worn by the handler must be closed toed. Handlers may not compete in bare feet. NO flip-flops or open toed shoes permitted.
21. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
22. All 'warm ups" MUST be done ON LEAD OUTDOORS. That means the lead is attached to the dog's collar and the handler is holding the lead. No Flexi Leads
23. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

IMPORTANT COVID-19 TRIAL INFORMATION

At the time of this premium MADTA is expecting that the trial/event will be able to be held as planned. All Trial decisions will be in accordance with the state of Florida, Federal, State, CDC and local government COVID-19 guidelines in place at the time of the trial/event.

Closing Date: 9/2/20 at 6:00 PM.

Should it come to pass that the trial/event needs to be cancelled because of virus restrictions, we will notify all participants via email **no later than the closing date.** (Your checks will not be cashed) After the closing date, the refund policy as outlined in this premium will remain in effect.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS/REQUESTS THAT YOU CAN EXPECT AT THE TRIAL/EVENT.

1. You will be **REQUIRED** to sign an Event Liability Waiver & Agreement in order to participate at the trial/event.
2. Limited **INDOOR CRATING** for participants. Thirty-eight, six foot by 6-foot (**38 - 6' x 6'**) areas will be marked on the floor. Please stack crates, bring your own chair. NO spectators. KEEP AISLE FREE. **CRATES MUST BE REMOVED EACH DAY FOR BUILDING CLEANING!**
3. We will be taking your temperature each day at the trial/event and you will be issued a colored bracelet (different color for each day you participate) which we request that your wear. Wearing the bracelet will indicate that your temperature was taken and you do not have a fever.
4. Paper course maps will NOT be available to hand out. Maps will be emailed. They will be displayed in several locations at the trial/event. Please come prepared to photograph the course map that applies to your class.
5. Briefings/walkthroughs, expect social distancing briefings, and smaller walkthroughs. Maximum of 8 at a time.
6. Social distancing will be in effect. You will be **required to wear your mask while in the building**. It will be optional for you to wear your mask in the ring. However, mask use will be based upon the federal/state/local/CDC guidelines at the time. If you do not have a mask MADTA will have them for sale at \$2.00 each.
7. Three (3) dogs and handlers will be allowed in the ring area at one time (the dog working in the ring and the next two (2) on deck). Areas will be marked for the two (2) on deck to maintain proper social distancing.
8. Food will **NOT** be available onsite. Please plan on bringing our own lunch, water, drinks, and water for dogs, etc.
9. Parking: A parking attendant will be on hand at the MADTA building in an offsite trial please leave appropriate social distance between cars.
10. All participants are expected to follow, federal, state, local, and CDC event and facility guidelines. Full details will be included in the judging schedule

AKC Titling Requirements Temporarily Amended – Obedience/Rally/Agility

July 16, 2020

To All Clubs Licensed for Obedience, Rally and Agility:

To better assist clubs and exhibitors during this unusual time in our sports, the Obedience, Rally and Agility departments received approval by the AKC Board of Directors to change the number of judges required for awarding some titles in obedience, rally and agility. Due to the travel restrictions and other local regulations impacting the country from COVID-19, many clubs are struggling to bring in judges from outside their area, plus exhibitors are looking to stay close to home.

This change will eliminate the requirement that two different judges are required for the titles shown below that require three qualifying scores (legs) to earn the titles. The change is effective retroactively to July 1, 2020 and will be in effect through December 31, 2020. The Regulations suspension will be revisited at the end of the year.

For all of the titles listed at the bottom of this announcement exhibitors may earn three qualifying scores (legs) under the same judge through December 31, 2020.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (Black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
