



MEMBER VOLUNTEER REWARDS PROGRAM

MADTA Policy # 12

Effective Date: March 1, 2018

As a non-profit dog training club, MADTA depends on volunteers to carry out its mission to foster and promote the welfare of dogs, hold American Kennel Club and other performance events, and promote good sportsmanship. In order to recognize the hard work of the volunteers, we have implemented a member volunteer rewards program. Volunteers will be able to earn and redeem MADTA “Bucks” for time spent in support of MADTA sanctioned trials and other events and activities.

**MADTA “Bucks” earned at sanctioned trials will be dispersed to volunteers according to the procedures established by the individual Trial Committees.**

MADTA “Bucks” earned at other events and activities must be recorded on a volunteer log. You can earn one MADTA “Buck” for each hour of volunteer work completed. In order to qualify for these rewards, members must perform 20 hours of volunteer work. As soon as you have accumulated 20 volunteer hours, you may submit your volunteer log to receive \$20 in MADTA “Bucks”. Members will be responsible for recording volunteer hours on a form provided by MADTA. Examples of volunteer work include:

Along with other MADTA activities that will require volunteers as determined by the board.

MADTA Bucks are valid for one year from date of issue, and can be used for up to \$20.00 toward the fee for classes, Sho-n-Gos/fun days, seminars, the awards program, membership renewal, etc., and other events and activities specified by the Board. **They can be used for trial entry fees, if allowed and as specified in the trial premium.**

Officers, Directors, Instructors and Assistant Instructors earn benefits specified in separate policies and do not earn MADTA “Bucks” for volunteering those specific duties.
