Pursuant to UKC rules, dogs may enter both Agility I and Agility II, but the U-AGII title will not be awarded until the requirements for U-AGI are completed. Dogs must already have the U-ACH title to enter Agility III

AG-I and AG-II are divided, 'A' classes are for dogs that have not earned a title at that level. U-ACH points are only earned from the 'B' classes. Please include your dog's UKC agility titles as part of your dog's name on the entry form. This will assist the Trial Secretary in assuring that you are entered in the correct class.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs enter in the trial.

- Dogs up to 10 inches.....Toy Division (4" hurdle and Hoop)
- Dogs over 10 inches up to 14 inches. Division 1 (8" Hurdle and Hoop)
- Dogs over 14 inches up to 20 inches.... Division 2 (14" Hurdle and Hoop)
- Dogs over 20 inchesDivision 3 (20" Hurdle and Hoop)

BE SURE TO NOTE YOUR DOG'S HEIGHT ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.

BE SURE TO INDICATE IF YOUR DOG IS RUNNING VETERAN JUMPS.

BE SURE TO SPECIFY 'A' or 'B' CLASS FOR AG-I and AG-II, INCLUDE ALL UKC AGILITY TITLES WITH THE DOG'S NAME ON THE ENTRY FORM.

Obstacles used will be listed in the UKC Agility rules. Each dog entered in AG-I A or B and AG-II A or B will be permitted to have course familiarization as allowed by the UKC rules. A warm-up jump will be set up by the trial ring.

CLASSES OFFERED: URO1 – URO2 – URO3 (All Divisions A, B, C.)

Rally Class 1A: Any exhibitor who has not handled a dog to a UKC Rally (URO1) title or traditional Obedience title, or its equivalent in another organization. Any dog that has not earned a title in UKC Rally or traditional UKC Obedience, or its equivalent title in another organization.

Rally Class 1B: The B class is open to all eligible dogs and handlers. The exhibitor does not need to own the dog entered

Rally Class 1C: Any dog that has earned the URO1 title. Exhibitor does not need to own the dog entered

Rally Class 2A: A dog must have earned the United Rally 1 title (URO1). • Any exhibitor who has not handled a dog to a UKC Rally (URO2) title or its equivalent in another other organization. Any exhibitor who has not handled a dog to a UKC traditional Obedience Companion Dog Excellent (UCDX) title or equivalent Obedience titles in any other organization. Rally Class 2B. A dog must have earned the United Rally 1 title (URO1). Any dog or handler that has earned a URO1 title or higher.

Rally Class 3A: s. A dog must have earned the United Rally 2 title (URO2). Any exhibitor who has not handled a dog to a UKC Rally 3 (URO3) title or an equivalent Rally title in any other organization. Exhibitor who has not handled a dog to a UKC traditional Obedience Companion Dog Excellent (UCDX) title or equivalent Obedience titles in any other organization. Any dog that has not earned the RO3 title, UCDX title, or an equivalent Rally or Obedience title in any other organization.

Rally Class 3B: A dog must have earned the United Rally 2 title (URO2). Any dog or handler that has earned a URO2 title or higher.

Special awards will be given to HIGH in Trial for each Rally Trial

OBEDIENCE TRIAL INFORMATION

Obedience trials will be indoors on fully matted ring
Obedience entries limited to 55 entries per judge per day.
Obedience will start at 9:00am

Pre-Novice Class. Any exhibitor with any dog that has not earned a Novice (UCD) title or its equivalent in any other organization may compete in this class. The exhibitor does not need to own the dog entered. Exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this class.

Beginner Novice Class. Any exhibitor with any dog that has not earned an Open (UCDX) title or its equivalent in any other organization may be entered in this class. The exhibitor does not need to own the dog entered. Exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this division

Novice A: The exhibitor must own the dog or must be a member of the recorded owner's immediate family. Any exhibitor who has not handled a dog to a Novice (UCD) title or its equivalent may be entered in this class. Any dog that has not earned a Novice (UCD) title or its equivalent in any other organization may be entered in this class. Exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this division. **Novice B:** Any exhibitor with any dog that has not earned a Novice (UCD) title may compete in this division. The exhibitor does not need to own the dog entered. Exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this division.

Novice C: Only dogs that have earned a UKC Novice (UCD) title may compete in this division. Exhibitor does not need to own the dog entered. Exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this division. Dogs that have earned the Obedience Champion (UOCH) title or its equivalent in any other organization are not eligible to compete in the Novice C class. For any handler and dog that has earned a U-CD title or higher.

Open A: Exhibitor must own the dog entered or be a member of the recorded owner's immediate family. For a dog that has not earned a Companion Dog Excellent (UCDX) title or its equivalent in any other organization may compete in this division. An exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this class.

Open B: Any exhibitor with any dog that has earned a Novice (UCD) title or higher may compete in this division. The exhibitor does not need to own the dog entered. Exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this class.

Utility A: The exhibitor must own the dog entered or be a member of the recorded owner's immediate family. Exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this class. Any dog that has not earned a Utility Dog (UUD) title or its equivalent in any other organization may compete in this division.

Utility B: Any exhibitor with any dog that has earned Open (UCDX) title or higher may compete in this division. The exhibitor does not need to own the dog entered. Exhibitor may show two or more dogs in this class.

Special Awards will be given to High in Trial for each obedience trial

Marion Alachua Dog Training Assoc. Inc. (MADTA) is making every effort to make sure you are attending a safe trial/event environment. However please be aware that you are participating at **YOUR OWN RISK.**

OTHER REQUIREMENTS/REQUESTS THAT YOU CAN EXPECT AT THE TRIAL/EVENT.

1. You will be **REQUIRED** to sign an Event Liability Waiver & Agreement in order to participate at the trial/event.
2. Limited **INDOOR CRATING** for participants.
3. We will be taking your temperature each day at the trial/event and you will be issued a colored bracelet (different color for each day you participate) which we request that you wear. Wearing the bracelet will indicate that your temperature was taken and you do not have a fever.
4. Briefings/walkthroughs, expect social distancing briefings, and smaller walkthroughs. Maximum of 8 at a time.
5. Social distancing will be in effect. You will be **required to wear your mask while in the building.** It will be optional for you to wear your mask in the ring. However, mask use will be based upon the federal/state/local/CDC guidelines at the time
6. Three (3) dogs and handlers will be allowed by the ring area at one time (the dog working in the ring and the next two (2) on deck). Areas will be marked for the two (2) on deck to maintain proper social distancing.
7. Food will **NOT** be available onsite. Please plan on bringing our own lunch, water, drinks, and water for dogs, etc.
8. Parking: A parking attendant will be on hand at the MADTA building. Handicapped Parking with proper tags only will be allowed to park by the building.
9. All participants are expected to follow, federal, state, local, and CDC event and facility guidelines
